Mr. Coggins reported that the Fiber Optic Broadband feasibility study is now complete and is on Eastgate Regional Council of Government's web site if anyone wants to read it, and he will work to get it on the Commissioners' and Planning Commission's web sites. He also stated that we are working with the Regional Chamber and several partners to help located a business in Trumbull County known as project Xpresso, AKA Transglobal, which received Enterprise Zone Tax Incentives in the amount of 40 percent for 10 years to build a 42,000-square-foot facility to assemble parts in the electric vehicle supply charge industry. He also stated that the Planning Commission submitted a 2021 CHIP application at the end of June.

Mrs. Phillips stated that there were 21 applications completed in June. She reported that the Commissioners had a public hearing on June 30, 2021, for the amendments to the Trumbull County Subdivision Regulations at the Commissioners' Hearing Room and the Planning Commission will be asked to adopt them under Other Business/Updates on this agenda today.
