EMERGENCY HOUSING ASSISTANCE

Trumbull County Commissioners are currently operating a Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Grant. Due to impacts of COVID-19 Trumbull County will be utilizing some of those funds to aid Low to Moderate Income Households that were affected by shutdowns with eligible activities of Emergency Housing Assistance. An applicant does not need to be late on any payments in order to qualify for the assistance. Applicants will need to complete an application provided by the Trumbull County Planning Commission and provide income verification as requested.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

- ◆ Applicant must be low-moderate income household as outlined per HUD guidelines. Annual Gross Income below 80% of the area median income. (Limits are revised annually)
- ◆ Applicant employment must be or have been affected by Covid-19, reduced hours, furloughed, or permanently laid off.

ELIGIBLE COSTS

- ◆ Monthly rent/lease payment up to 3 months
- ◆ Monthly mortgage payment up to 3 months

INELIGIBLE COSTS

- ◆ Home Remodeling/Improvement costs
- ◆ Streaming services (Netflix, Hulu, Disney+, etc..)
- ◆ Cable Television provider
- ◆ Additional household services (Lawn Care Services, Landscaping services, Laundry services, Household cleaning services, etc...)
